Flight Instruction

Flying a radio controlled model REQUIRES training before one can fly **SAFELY** and without crashing. Obtaining proper equipment to start the hobby is very important.

Our members have many years of experience in building and flying of radio controlled models. Most are eager to share their knowledge with current or prospective members. They are available to help with obtaining, building and learning to fly radio-controlled models.

Flight instruction is offered at no charge to members. Beginner's night is on Thursday evening from May through October. Priority will be given to beginners flying with instructors. Anyone desiring instruction needs to make arrangements ahead of time with an instructor.

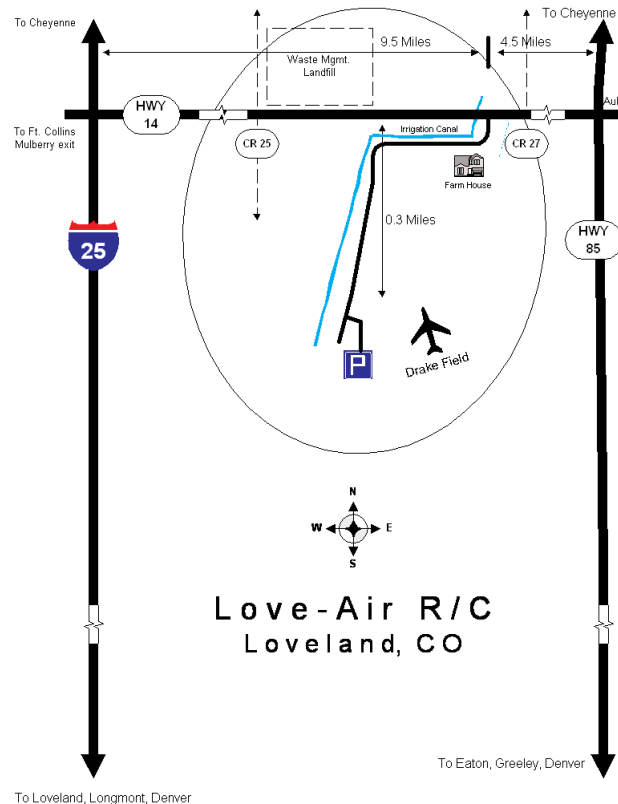

- Three Asphalt Taxiways

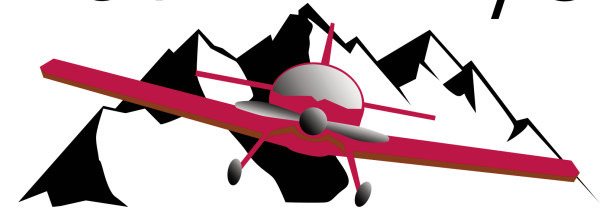
